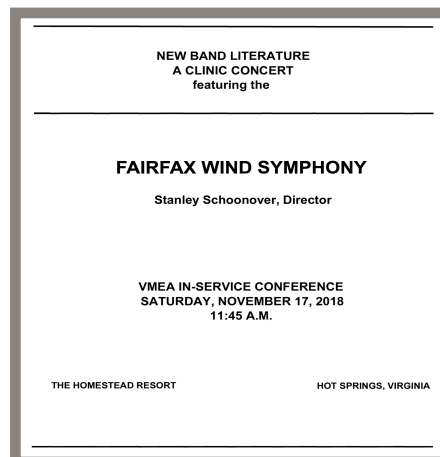
Fairfax Wind Symphony



The Fairfax Wind Symphony was formed in the fall of 1999 for the benefit of local music directors and teachers. Its' primary focus is to read and prepare wind literature of all grade levels, and to explore contemporary rehearsal techniques and procedures. In addition to presenting numerous local concerts, the ensemble has been featured at thirteen VMEA In-service Conferences, appeared at the Kennedy Center five times, performed at the GMU Potomac Festival three times, the 2016 ACB Convention and presented a concert upon invitation for the 2006 Mid-West Clinic. Annual concerts shared with the GMU Wind Symphony are also a tradition, starting with the 2002 season. 501c3 status as a charitable organization was granted in 2015. Players volunteer their time for all performances.
